Nice example of the much sought after large format survey of San Diego Bay, form the US Coast Survey.

Extends from False (Mission) Bay and the Pacific Beach area, south to Imperial Beach and the Mexican border. Hundreds of soundings. Shows several of the Ranchos, New San Diego, Old Town, Ballast Pt., La Playa, Valley of Tecolote, a Light House, Valley of Carbonera, and the old and new river beds of the San Diego River, among other things.

This is one of three maps of San Diego Bay by the US Coast Survey, the other two (1851 and 1853) are much smaller format.
