Warren Heckrotte comments that "Mallery was responsible for an earlier map of Arizona: Department of Arizona. Revised 1875. Office of the Chief of Engineers, U.S. Army, Washington, D.C. 1876. First Lieut. J.C. Mallery, Corps of Engineers, Chief Engineer. Under the authority of Major General J.M. Schofield.
