Scarce map of Mexico, Texas, upper California, and contiguous parts of the Southwest, on the eve of Texas colonization.

The present map is the first edition of Lizar's map, which in a later edition would name the "Republic of Texas." The map also bears a note stating: *Note . . . The boundary between Mexico on the north and the United States is a line drawn from Cape Mendocino, (Lat. 40° 28' 40") Eastward to the Rocky Mountains. Mines indicated by cross, thus +.*
