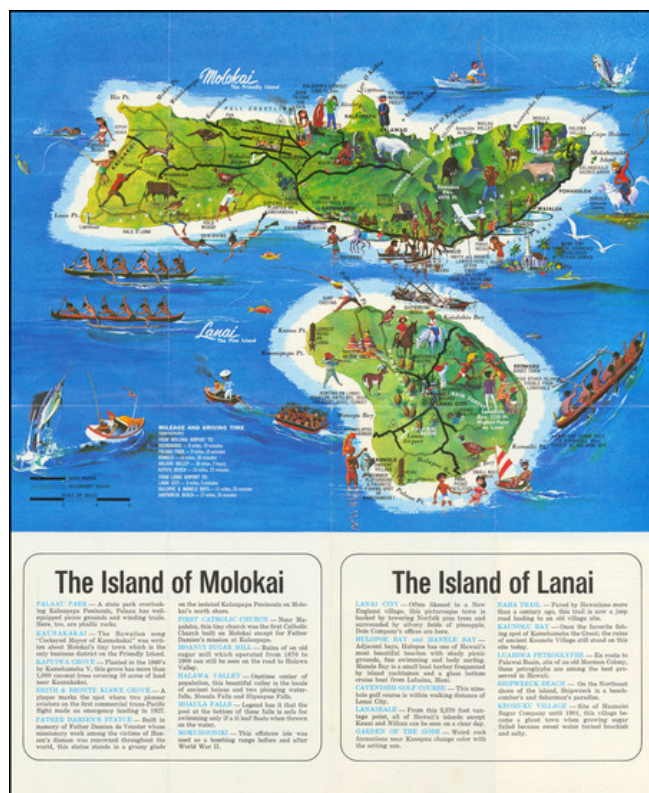

town. On Molokai there is Father Damien's Statue which commemorates the work of Father Damien de Veuster who worked with victims of Hansen's disease.

Furthermore, natural wonders like Moaula Falls where the pool is only safe for swimming if a ti leaf floats atop it according to legend are popular with locals and visitors. This map, thus, serves not just as a practical guide, but as an invitation to delve into the many wonders and stories that Molokai and Lanai hold.
