## **Description:**

A handsome example of Herman Moll's two-sheet map of France, with place names keyed in alphabetical tables.

The post roads are clearly marked and a slightly unusual feature is Moll's list of thirty-two numbered passes through the Pyrenees.

A highly emblematic cartouche has images of the rival observatories of Paris and Greenwich outlined on distant hills.

Engraving on two sheets of 18th-century laid paper joined as one. Original hand-color in outline. Some toning at the top of the vertical wing folds. VG to VG+
