## **Description:**

Nice example of the rare map of Spain, published by Andreas Shottus in his rare work *Hispaniæ Illustratæ* seu rerum *Urbinumque Hispaniæ*, *Lusatiæ*, Æthiopiæ et Indiæ Scriptes Varii", published in Frankfurt 1603-1608.

The map closely follows Ortelius' map of Spain, but with a number of minor differences, including the lack of Ortelius' privilege in the lower right corner of the map.

Strong dark impression with wide margins. Large cartouche, 2 sea monsters and two ships. Ortelius in turn based his map on the map of Carolus Clusius or Charles de l'Escluse (1526-1609) a botanist by profession, who published a 6 sheet map of Spain in 1571.

## **Detailed Condition:**

A bit of staining at the outer edges, far from the printed image.
