## **Description:**

Fine example of Jan Baptiste Vrients map of the Low Countries and environs, which first appeared in the 1608 edition of Abraham Ortelius' *Theatrum Orbis Terrarum*, the first modern atlas of the world.

The map is based upon a wall map of Philip Galle, published in Antwerp in 1575, of which no known example survives. The map is known to exist in 4 states, the first of which is known in a single copy. States 3 and 4 were issued separately post-1612. The present example is the second state, which includes the Vrients imprint.

The map is embellished with 17 coats of arms, elaborate cartouche and compass rose and naval scenes.
