

Large format map of the region centered on Lake Winnepeg and showing Riviere Skatehawan ou Fleuve Bourbon in the Northwest, the Missouri River and Assinniboines in the Southwest, Nenawecouhen and Lake Pike in the Northeast and the Lake of the Woods and L. Rouge in the Southeast.

Includes parts of North Dakota and northern Minnesota, as well as Southern Manitoba, Southeastern Saskatchewan and Southwestern Ontario.

Includes a number of English forts, factories and locations of the Northwest Company and Hudson's Bay Company, along with Indian Settlements. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
