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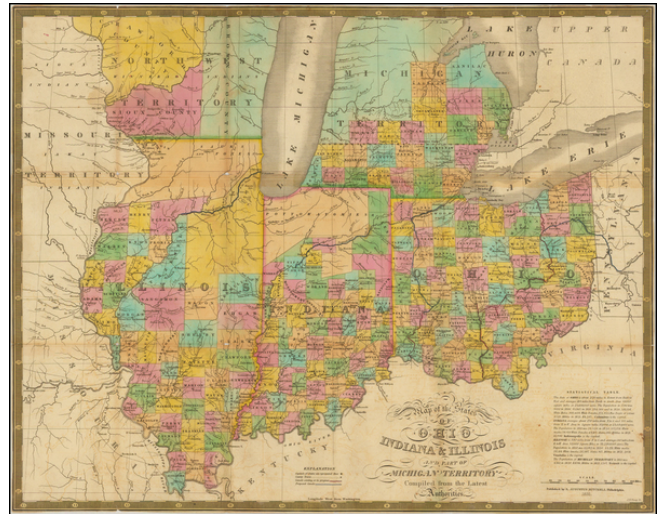
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Map of the States of Ohio Indiana & Illinois, with Part of Michigan Territory Compiled From The Latest Authorities . . . 1831

Description:

Detailed large format map of the Midwest, which appeared in SA Mitchell's *New American Atlas*.

Michigan is still a territory, with only 21 counties and only a small group of towns.

Illinois includes several large unnamed areas in the north, ending at the Sauks and Foxes Indian Boundary.

Indiana is dominated in the North by an oversized Pottowatamie Indian lands region.

The Northwest Territory is still shown, including 3 large counties (Brown, Sioux and Crawford).

The map also extends into Missouri and Missouri Territory, including the lands of the Sioux and Ioway Indians. A number of early roads are shown, as are some early township surveys in Michigan Territory. Statistical Table includes information on size, population, historical populations and Capitals.

The map was first issued by Finley in 1826 and significantly updated and revised by Mitchell in 1831.
