Detailed regional map of Thuringia in Germany.

Shows the region between the Werra and Sala Rivers, centered on Erfurt.

The present map was produced by two of the primary Cologne School mapmakers, Johann Bussemacher and Matthias Quad. The Cologne School of cartography, was perhaps the only group of mapmakers competing with the Low Countries-based map publishing houses at the end of the 16th century (De Jode and Ortelius).
