This view first appeared in Valentijn's *Oud en Nieuw Oost-Indien*. . ., which was a five-part, eight-volume masterpiece which informed European readers about Southeast Asia and was based on Valentijn's trips to the East Indies for the V.O.C. (Dutch East India Company).
