Finely executed map of the Maneuver Grounds in Prince William County and Fairfax County, Virginia, drawn by future Brigadier General George R. Spalding, under the directions of Major Edward Burr of the Army Corps of Engineers.

The map was prepared shortly after Spalding's return from the Philippines, during the Spanish American War.

Spalding would go on to become an important officer in the Corps of Engineers, publishing the *Manual in Topography, Map Reading and Reconnaissance: Prepared by Major George R. Spalding ... Under the Direction of the Chief of Engineers, U.S. Army* in 1918.
