

Fine original antique map showing northern Russia, including the eastern part of the Island of Nova Zemlya and the northern part of the Taz River. This map was published by Philippe Vandermaelen in Brussels.

The map includes several place names in French throughout the map. Routes of early explorers are shown, including Russian voyages from the 1730s and 1740s.

This map first appeared in Vandermaelen's remarkable 6-volume atlas of the world. The atlas is composed of sheets covering the entire known world at the time, which, if combined as globe gores, form an immense globe. As such, Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
