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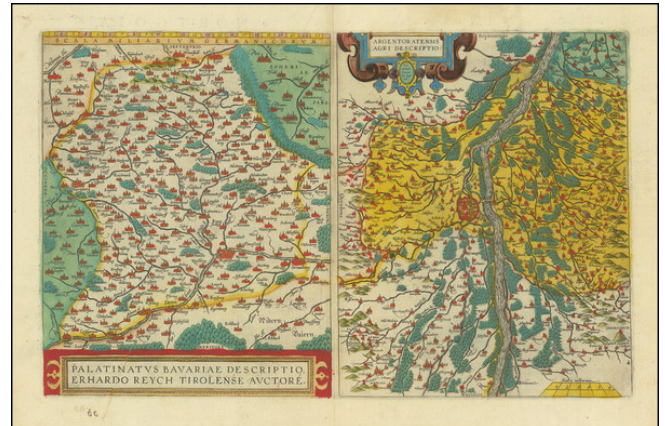

***Blinding Original Hand-Color!***

A truly handsome pair of maps on a single sheet by Abraham Ortelius.

The map of Bavaria at the left is based on that by Erhart Reich. It includes the cities of Regensburg, Nuremberg, Bamberg, and Straubing, part of Bohemia to the northeast, and "Nidern Baiern", or lower Bavaria, to the southeast.

The map of the Strasbourg region is based on Daniel Specklin's 1576 three-sheet map of the Elzas (Alsace) and prominently features the Rhine.

From Ortelius' *Theatrum Orbis Terrarum*, the first modern atlas of the world.
