At the bottom of the map is an engraving of the "new" Ohio Statehouse building. Ohio had planned to build a new statehouse building for years, but the project took on urgency in 1852 when the old Ohio Statehouse burned down. The construction of the new statehouse lasted until 1861.

Colton's "Railroad & Township" maps tend to be some of the largest and most detailed maps of a particular state that he issued.

This appears to be the second edition released a year after the very scare first edition.
