Fine original antique road map of the region between London & Portsmouth.

This map was published as part of John Ogilby's traveler's guide, a detailed treatment of the roads of England and Wales.

This map is particularly interesting for its non-traditional representation used. Embodying a one-dimensional map, in which all detail is limited to the region alongside this road, the map would have been of immense use to the 18th-century traveler.

Generally oriented with south at the top, the map starts in London and travels through Clapham and Bootersey Heath to Kingstone, Cobham, Ripley, Guildford, Godalmin, Lippock, Petersfield, and Cosham, before reaching Portsmouth on the English Channel.
