Description:

Rare regional map from Du Val's Le Monde Terrestre, based upon Sanson's 1657 map. The major difference is the prominence given the Rio del Spiritu Santu (Mississippi River), which pushed far west of its true location and course. Caroline is named at Port Royal, and the French claim to the Region is identified. This is the second state, with the G.O.D.R. (Geographer to the King) status conferred upon Du Val. While Du Val had previously used information by Lescarbot, this map uses the more up to date information contained in Sanson's map. A seminal map for collectors of Texas, the South, Florida and the Mid-Continent regions of the US. Cumming 57, Burden 352 (State 2), Pasterneau pp135-7 & 162-5.
