Attractive example of Lotter's map of North America.

While California has not actually been attached to the mainland, it is clearly now present in its peninsular format. The map is based upon De L'Isle's landmark map of 1700. Includes an elaborate decorative cartouche and excellent detail throughout. The tracks of a number of explorers' routes are shown along the west coast. Interesting treatment of the Mississippi River Valley.

### Detailed Condition:

A nice old color example. Minor split at lower centerfold, just entering the map, else a nice example.
