Gorgeous map of Andalusia, extending from Las Sierras de Ronda to Corduba and Sierra Morena to El Cerro and Aroche to Castromarin and Lepe, centered on Sevilla, with the Bay of Cadiz at the lower center. Three cartouches and a naval battle are shown, along with 4 or 5 sea monsters. Wide clean margins and a nice example, with minor repaired tears in the margins, far from the printed image. A rich dark impression and overall fine handsomely colored example. From the 1601 Latin edition of Ortelius' Theatrum Orbis Terrarum, the first modern atlas.
