The map's detailed treatment of Texas, includes explorers routes and dates. The treatment of the Mississippi and Missouri Valleys are extraordinary, if inaccurate. The projection of the Great Lakes, Gulf Coast, Florida and the Southwest are also outstanding. Large insets of Annapolis & the mouths of the Mississippi and Mobile. Too much detail to describe. An exception example of this seminal Americana map; the best regional English map prior to Popple.
