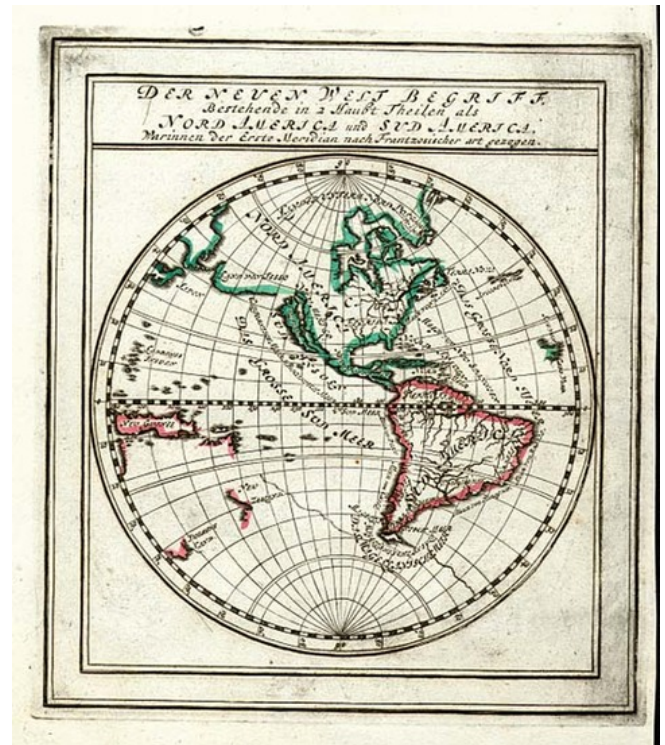

### Description:

Scarce map of the Western Hemisphere from Bodenehr's rare Atlas Curieux. This map was part of a comparative cartography section of the Atlas, which contrasted the mapping of the Western Hemisphere by the Dutch (this map) and the French (entry #1832). This map shows California as an island on the Briggs/Goos model, w/no Northwest Coastline about California. South America is badly distorted. No sign of the Great Lakes. The rivers & mountains on each continent are very different from #1831. A partial New Zealand Coastline is present, but no sign of Australia. Almost no sign of New Guinea. There is no land south of Tierra del Fuego in the Antarctic region. A marvelous map, especially in a pair w/ #1831.
