Description:

Rare miniature map of the Northern Colonies, extending west to the Ohio River, Lake Michigan and Green Bay, from John Gibson's Atlas Minimus, the first miniature English Atlas to include a number of regional maps of the Colonies. The western detail of the map is interesting, showing Ft. St. Joseph, Sanduski, the Villages of the Hurons and Utanvas, St. Mary's and St. Mary's Falls, Muskingum, Hockhocken, Shanvanoah, Ft. duQuesne, Kiskiskies, Tuscarora and Bacealoons. Ft. Frontenac, Ft. Hunter, and Ft. Oswego appear, as does a Storehouse between Lake Erie and Lake Ontario. Nice annotations on the region are included. A terrific American Miniature, which rarely appears on the market. This is one of the few works to include regional maps of the colonies at the time of the French & Indian War.
