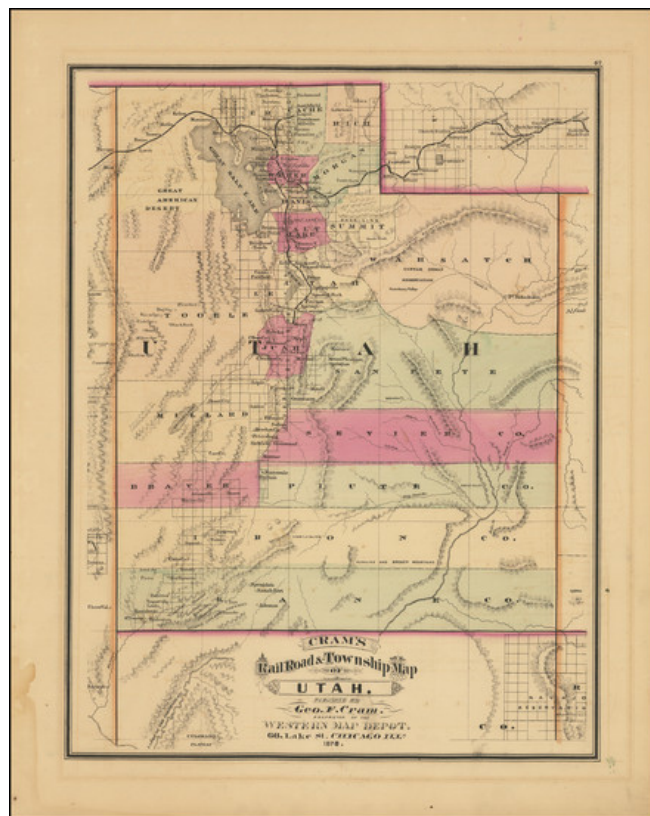

### Description:

Rare early railroad map of Utah.

Includes topographical detail, railroads, cities, Indian Reservations, Forts, Post Offices, and a host of other details.

George Cram would become one of the most prolific atlas publishers of the last 19th and early 20th Centuries. However, his earliest maps, issued in the late 1860s, were marvelous separately issued railroad maps. His success led to the publication of two editions of his now impossibly rare *New Commercial Atlas of the United States* in 1875 and 1879, which included a number of Cram's rare separately issued railroad maps.
