A fantastic double-elephant plate from the first edition of John James Audubon's monumental work The Birds of America features the Turkey Buzzard (*Cathartes Atratus*).

The image shows an adult male perched atop a short section of branch, prominently displayed at the upper part of the composition. Below, a juvenile bird suns its wings on a similarly short branch. A significant compositional element is a vertical tree trunk positioned to the right, serving as an anchor to which both branches are attached, enhancing the structural integrity and visual balance of the scene.
