We find marked on this map the Werder of Dantzic, on the left bank of the Wistula, between Dantzic and Dirschaw; that of Marienburg which is enclosed between the Wistule, the Nogat and the Gulf of Dantrig that of Elbing located between the Lake and the River Deforge, the Nogat, and the Gulf of Dantzic. These three Cantons or small Countries were dried up by means of a large number of Canals made by the hands of man, which made them very fertile . .
