Description:

Striking map of Scandinavia by Louis Stanislas d'Arcy de la Rochette, which appeared in Faden's *General Atlas*.

This early addition pre-dates the Napoleonic Wars and shows Norway and Denmark as unified and Finland as part of Sweden.

The map reflects the art of map printing at one of its high points, employing high-quality handmade paper, fine copperplate engraving, and rich elegant hand coloring.

The detail throughout the map is remarkable and is embellished with a decorative cartouche.



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The map shows towns, duchies, rivers, lakes, roads, bays, islands and a host of other important details.

One of the most attractive 18th Century maps of Scandinavia.
