

## **Description:**

Nice example of the Faden edition of Thomas Jeffery's double-page engraved map of northwestern Germany, which was, at the time, the Dominion of George III.

George III was concurrently Duke and prince-elector of Brunswick-Lüneburg ("Hanover") in the Holy Roman Empire until his promotion to King of Hanover on 12 October 1814. He was the third British monarch of the House of Hanover, but unlike his two predecessors, he was born in Britain, spoke English as his first language, and never visited Hanover.
