## **Description:**

This excellent 19th-century map details the Haring or Herring Farm in New York City, originally surveyed in 1784 by David Haring. The map shows the farm's original perimeter along with accurately laid down streets and avenues as of January 1869. It also includes the partition of the farm into various lots assigned to different individuals, reflecting land ownership and changes over time. The map covers areas that now include Washington Square Park, the Bowery, and parts of the West Village, which encompasses much of what is now NYU's campus.
