

Description:

This fantastic drawing of an Indian vine snake of the genus *Ahaetulla* is attributed to Johannes Schumacher, an associate of William Paterson, the famous explorer, natural history collector, and eventual Lieutenant Governor of New South Wales.

Based on a partially effaced inscription, we conclude that the drawing was made at Syringham, Mysore, India, shortly after the conclusion of the Second Anglo-Mysore War, probably for William Paterson, who fought in the war. A detailed discussion of the attribution of the drawings and other related ones is presented in the following essay.

The inscription reads:

Patche = Pamboo / The Green Snake of size / The Natives say its bite is Death but I could find no poison fangs in its Jaw. [J.S.] / Syringham. [1785?]

Detailed Condition:

Original ink and watercolor drawing on a sheet of late-18th-century laid Whatman paper watermarked "JWhatman" (see main description for a discussion of the dating significance of the watermark). Two short tears at the right edge. Ink inscription along the bottom margin. Ruled in red as for a ledger book.
