Extends from the German Alpes to Nuremberg and Frieburg in the north. Major cities include Munich, Regensberg, Augsburg, Ingolstadt, etc. From the 1592 Latin edition of Ortelius' Theatrum Orbis Terrarum, the first modern atlas of the world. Two decorative cartouches and elaborate scale. Fold split at upper centerfold and some manuscript notes in the margins. Van den Broeke 110.
