A highly unusual map, showing the discoveries and explorations of Marquette and Joliet, one of the very few early regional maps to focus on the Mississippi Valley and one of the first maps of the Mississippi River. While highly inaccurate in retrospect, the map provides exceptional detail of the Indian Tribes, settlements, mountains, rivers, lakes and other regional features, including several early French forts. An essential map for collectors of the Mississippi Valley, Great Lakes, Plains and Midwest. Only the 2nd time we have ever offered the map, and the first time with the decorative framed border.
