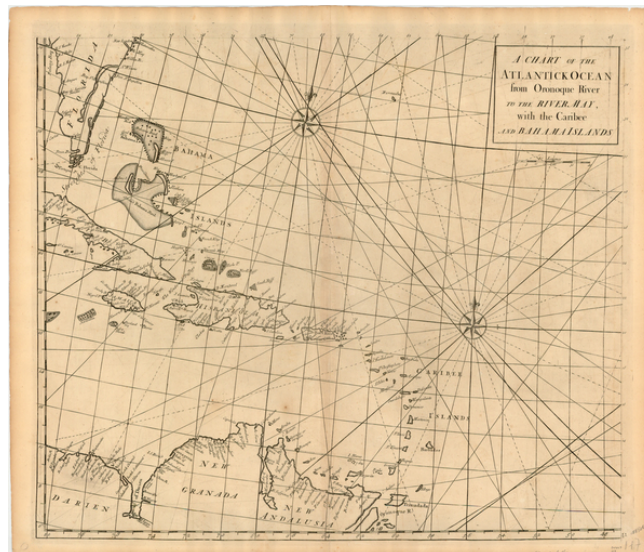

Description:

Rare 4 sheet map of the Atlantic Ocean, including an excellent treatment of the East Coast of North America, and a large inset of the Chesapeake Region.

This map appeared in the *Atlas Maritimus et Commercialis*, published in London in 1728 as a competitor to the *English Pilot*. Such famous names as Edmund Halley and Daniel Defoe contributed to the publication, along with John Senex. The large format inset of the Chesapeake region is of particular note, being one of the largest format and most detailed chartings of the region to date. Over 100 place names are shown, along with soundings, shoals, etc. New Jarsey and East New Jarsey are named, as are Bergen County, Essex County, Middlesex and others. Includes excellent detail around NYC. The treatment of the Florida region is also quite interesting.

While loose sheets occasionally appear on the market, we are not aware of the 4 sheets being offered as a set in either at auction or in a dealer catalogue in the past 25 years. A fine uncolored set, with wide clean margins.
