## **Description:**

Fourth state of Van Keulen's chart of Hudson Bay and Arctic Canada, which includes significant updates and many new place names not shown on the 1680 or 1681 editions of the map and an entirely new coastline for the west coast of Greenland.

The map shows the region around the Northwest Passage and entrance to Hudson's Bay. The map is based upon Van Loon's map of 1666 and is copied directly from Hendrik Doncker's chart of 1678 (Doncker's shop being just across the street). In this third state of the map, a portion of the coast of Greenland has been updated and ther are mountains now added along a number of the coastlines. Among the most noteworthy updates, this is the first edition to include the name of Hudson's Bay (Bay Hudson) on the map. This is also the first edition of the map to name James Bay, although it is erroneously located well north of its proper location.
