A nice dark impression. Decorative cartouche and massive sailing ship. Based upon Cornelis Anthoniszoon's Caerte van Oostand, and maps by Sgrotehn, Olaus and Jordanus. From the 1574 edition of Oretlius' Theatrum Orbis Terrarum, the first modern atlas of the World. Gorgeous example in full wash color, with wide margins. Van Den Broecke 84. Perhaps the most decorative 16th Century map of Denmark.
