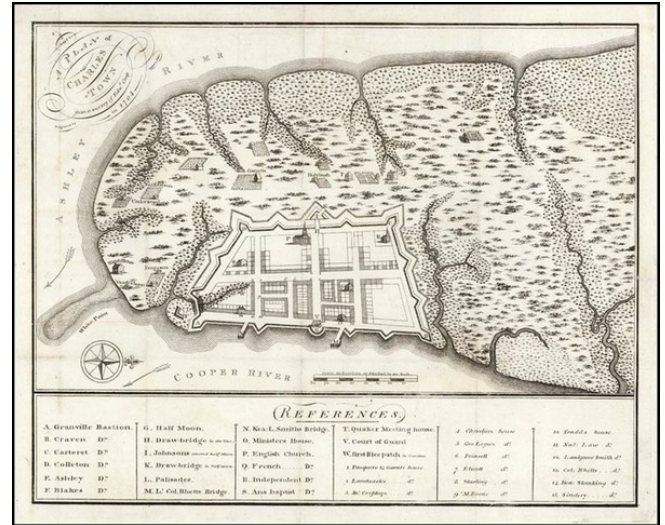


## A Plan of Charlestown from a survey of Edwd. Crisp in 1704

**Description:**

Scarce plan of Charleston from David Ramsay's History of South Carolina. The map is based upon Edward Crisp's rare 1704 plan of Charleston. The key below includes references to 36 places on the map. Several outlying farms are shown beyond the town grid and fortifications, including Vanderhorst, Ferguson, Underwood, Gilbertson, Garnetts, and Stobo The homes of 15 early settlers are also located. A good example of a scarce map. The original Crisp plan is essentially unobtainable, making this the only collectable example of the map.
