Scarce map of Florida, the Gulf Coast, Cuba and Jamaica based upon the voyages of Franciscus de Garay and other contemporary work. The map shows the Mississippi flowing into the Gulf of Mexico considerably west of its true location. There are a number of early settlements showing in Florida, Alabama and Mississippi, along with excellent detail in Cuba and the Yucatan. The map does not incorporate the work of Bisente and is still based largely on the projections of the Gulf Coast pioneered on maps such as Giovanni Battista Nicolosi's maps of 1660. A wonderful example of Vander Aa's scarce map of the Gulf Coast. Striking example, with gorgeous color.
