#### Description:

Sylvanus' map of the northern parts of Europe, from the Rhine in the west, the Danube in the south and the Vistula in the east, is one of the earliest obtainable maps of the region and the first printed in two colors. The map appeared in Sylvanus' *Claudii Ptholemaei Alexandrini liber Geographicae . . .*, publish in Venice in 1511.

The Sylvanus edition of Ptolemy is one of the earliest to include maps with modern geographical updates. The map has been printed on two leaves, which have here been rejoined and backed with Japan paper on the verso. A nice example of a map which very rarely appears on the market.
