Detailed map of Mexico, constructed shortly after the Gadsden Purchase and immediately prior to the Civil War. Arizona is shown below New Mexico (Baylor Line). Excellent notes along the border concerning inhabitation of the region, along with names of forts, springs, etc. along U.S. border. Missions shown. Inset of Isthmus of Tehuantepec. Margins trimmed but ample for farming. Two minor spots, but generally a nice example.
