Description:

Rare early edition of Blaeu's map of Colombia, part of Ecuador extending south to Esmeraldas, and Venezuela extending east nearly to Caracas. Includes 2 large compass roses, and two large cartouches. Provides excellent view of mid 17th Century Columbia, including the course of the Magdallena River and its major tributaries. From the 1634 German edition of Blaeu's Atlas Novus, the first edition of this seminal work. The map was first issued in the 1630 edition of Blaeu's Atlas Appendix, making this its third appearance in an atlas. Dark crisp impression and wide clean margins.
