A highly inaccurate map, both in shape and nomenclature. Shows both real and fictitious St. Helena Islands. The source of the Nile is inaccurately shown as two side by side lakes. A decorative, richly illustrated and highly detailed map of Africa, representing the best and worst of geographical knowledge of the continent. Minor toning, but overall a nice example.
