Nebraska extends to Canada and the Rocky Mountains. Misconfigured Texas and Indian Territory. Oregon Territory encompasses Washington, Idaho and parts of Wyoming and Utah. Massive Utah and New Mexico Territories. Perhaps the most curious feature is the elongated Kansas Territrory, which reaches considerably west of its actual boundary in the Rocky Mountains. Fine example with massive wide margins. First example of the map we have ever seen.
