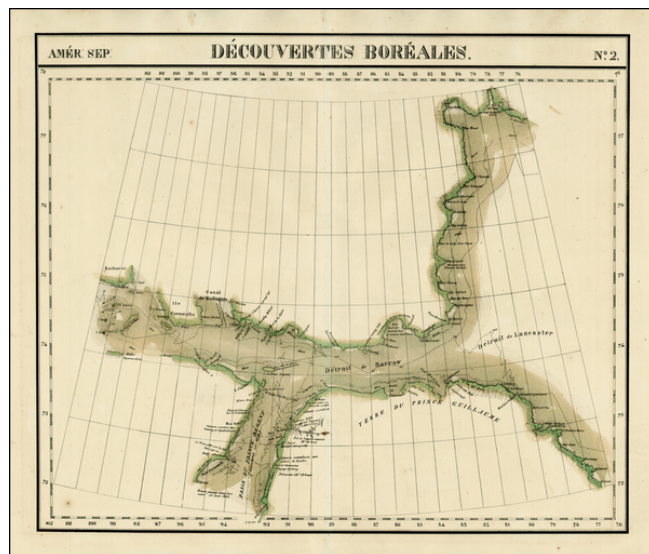

Large format map of the Lancaster and Barrow Straits, showing the northwest passage from the Baffin Sea to the Arctic Sea.

The map extends west to Bathurst, Ile Cornwallis, Canal De Wellington, and Pass Du Prince Regent discovered in 1819. In the center is Detroit de Barrow, with Detroit de Lancaster, etc in the west. A number of other exploration details and dates are given.

One of the most detailed maps of the English discoveries in the Arctic region in the early 19th Century. From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale.
