Description:

A scarce map of Indian Territories issued by the Commissioner of Indian Affairs and prepared by C.A. Maxwell the Chief of the Law and Land Division, Indian Bureau. John Olberg is listed as the Draftsman. This map is an interesting variant of the General Land Office Map, which includes a listing of the 31 land divisions in Indian Territory among the tribes which was generally lacking from most other Indian Territory maps. The map shows Treaties, Indian Villages, townships, Nation Capitals, Military Reservations, Roads & Trails, Railroads and Proposed Railroads, Lands selected by the Superintendent Recotr in 1859 for the Wichitas and other Indians, the Fort Reno Timber Reserve and other details. A very attractive and relatively scarce map.
