### Description:

Nice example of De Fer's map of the United States and Canada, from his *Atlas Curieux*. The present example includes a second sheet of text, which includes descriptions of Canada, Louisiana, Florida, New England, New York, New Iarsay, Pennsylvania, Virginia and Carolina.

The course of the Mississippi is virtually due North, originating in Texas and extending into Canada. The many rivers which feed the Mississippi are described and often annotated, most notably the Ohio ou Bell Riviere, which starts far south of its true origins and the Oubache River. The extend of Canada ou Nouvelle France is extended far to the south and the size of the English Colonies subsantially reduced, undoubtedly a political statement. Notes on early explorations, forts, rivers and Indian Tribes abound in this marvelous work, engraved by van Loon.
