Melish produced the first edition of this atlas during the War of 1812. While it was issued again in 1815 with additional maps, this version is the only true war edition. Includes towns, roads, distances, indian settlements, french encampments in Missouri Territory, Spanish Cantonments, Indian Boundaries in Illinois & Indiana Territories and other nice details. The is reminiscent of Melish's large US map of 1816. Lower left corner is trimmed to the neatline & the folds are supported by non-archival tape, without discoloration, else a nice example.
