

Description:

Scarce map of Abruzzo, from Rossi's rare Mercurio Geografico.

Major towns located include Ascoli, Aquila, Lanciano, Termoli and Pescara. The map is a tremendous example of the fine topograpical style of Rossi's maps, elegantly tracing rivers through steep and well defined mountain valleys. Includes a key in the lower left, depicting the symbols used on the map. An uncommon late 17th century map, based on the reports of Giacomo Cantelli da Vignola.

Abruzzo is a region in Italy, its western border lies east of Rome. The name Abruzzo appears to derive from Latin, although in Roman times the region was known at various times as Picenum, Sabina et Samnium, Flaminia et Picenum and Campania et Samnium.
