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

Massive wall map of North Dakota, originally issued as a folding map.

The map is colored by counties and notes towns, railroads, stations, Indian Reservations, Mountain Ranges, Elevations, and a host of other details. One of the most detailed maps of North Dakota published during the 1st decade of the 20th Century, on a Scale of 8 miles to 1 inch.
