

Scarce English edition of Venegas' map of Baja California and contiguous Mexico and parts of Southern Arizona along the Gila River.

This map was intended as a update of Fra. Eusebio Kino's map, produced by Consag and other Jesuit sources during the first half of the 18th Century. The map is once of the most detailed an in many respects fanciful maps of the Baja, combining the knowledge obtained by the Jesuits of the Mission system in the Baja and continguous regions with a fanciful eastern coast of Baja California.
