

Detailed map of the region bounded by the Canadian Rockies in the West and extending to the area around Carlton House (Fort Carleton) in the east, tracking the course of the 2 branches of the Saskatchewan River

The map includes Edmonton, Calgary, Regina, Saskatoon, Medicine Hat, Lethbridge and extends southwest to Kalispell, Idaho.

From Vandermaelen's remarkable 6 volume atlas, which if combined as globe gores forms an immense globe. Vandermaelen accomplished the first atlas mapping of the world on a uniform scale. A bit of spotting and soiling, but overall a nice map.
