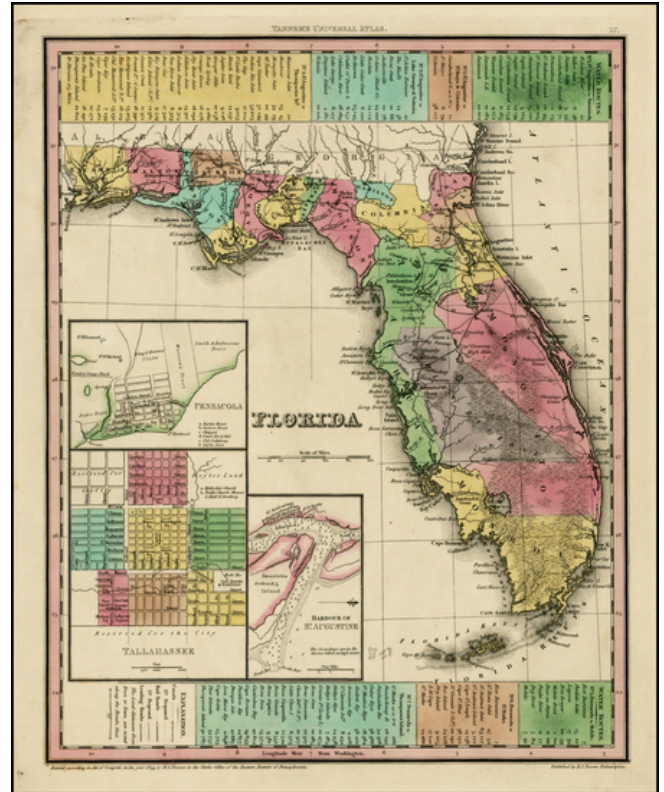

Description:

First edition of Tanner's map of Florida, with insets of Pensacola, Tallahassee and the Harbor of St. Augustine, from his *New Universal Atlas*.

In this first edition, there is a massive Indian Reserve which appears between Mosquito County and Alachua County, along with a line annotations stating "Undetermined Indian Boundary" and two other Indian Boundary Lines. There is a road traversing the southern swamps identified as "Tracks of the Indians." The Arrondondos Grant is shown in both Monroe County and Alachua County.

Shows many early forts, roads, rivers, lakes, the Everglades, etc.
